

Fondi is so ancient that to discover its origing we would have to search between Legends and Myths. The City, founded by Hercules is sadly and famously known as "The City of the Devil". After the great Oriental Schism promoted by the Count of Fondi, Onorato Caetani 1 in 1378, its history fits well in the planning of those in continuous search of spiritual, historic and environmental treasures. Fondi is known at international level for having sustained several seizures by invaders and foreign settlers, but always re-emerging better and stronger than before.
